

**MINUTES OF  
PICKLEBALL CLUB GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING  
HELD APRIL 25, 2013 AT HIDDEN CYPRESS**

Mike Wallick then went over several items for the members:

He plans on approaching CAM with some ideas about getting some type of seating /shade structure on the South Side courts and offering to pay for part of it with funds from the Club Building account. Also. He will see if there is any possibility to change the shade structures on the North Side courts as they are very ineffective. Also gates will not be installed between courts on the North Side. They will remain

as they are now.

Mike also wanted to remind players on the South Side courts to lower the umbrella when you are done playing if no one has shown up to play after you. Do not leave them up for a future group as they may not show up.
